Work Continues at Galilee Church

Little by little, the work continues at Galilee Church in Kasenga. After the roof was installed and the walls were raised to the roof, we began work on interior finishing. We installed custom fabricated windows in the lower level of the church, fourteen in all. Our desire was to install alternating panes of colored glass in the windows, but the low supply of glass due to covid-19 has prevented installation at this time. We continued by painting all of the window frames and doors over several days.







We asked the welder to fabricate double doors for the front entrance. The photo (above, right) shows the three dimensional design of God's hands releasing the dove of the Holy Spirit. (The design will be easier to see once the final painting is completed.) The windows and doors not only closed the building to damage from the elements, but also secured the building from unwanted visitors. There were more than a few chickens and goats who were not happy about this development!





A metal staircase was fabricated to enclose entry to the upper level, which was then primed and painted. With all the twists and turns in the metal bars, this became a tedious project. We continued by finishing the front (altar) wall. What a difference a coat of paint makes!
